

An Act to Begin the Scallop Season on November 30th Annually.

Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 26.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §6722**, as amended by PL 1983, c. 685, is
further amended to read:

6 **§6722. Closed areas**

8 Unless modified by regulation adopted under section 6171-A,
10 it is unlawful to fish for or take scallops in the coastal waters
from April 16th to ~~October--31st~~ November 29th, both days
12 inclusive.

14 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

16 This bill shortens the scallop harvesting season by one
18 month by lengthening the period when it is unlawful to fish for
or take scallops.
