SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1212, L.D. 1631, "Resolve, to Reclassify the Position of a Former Teacher's Aide"

Amend the amendment by inserting before the enacting clause the following:

**Mandate preamble.** This measure requires one or more local units of government to expand or modify activities so as to necessitate additional expenditures from local revenues but does not provide funding for at least 90% of those expenditures. Pursuant to the Constitution of Maine, Article IX, Section 21, two thirds of all of the members elected to each House have determined it necessary to enact this measure.'

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of the fiscal note and inserting in its place the following:

**FISCAL NOTE**

Any additional salary costs that result from an employee-initiated reclassification of a teacher aid or teacher assistant position will represent a state mandate. The additional costs of this state mandate will be minor. Pursuant to the mandate preamble, a 2/3 vote of all members elected to each House exempts the State from the constitutional requirement to fund 90% of the additional local costs.

Any such reclassifications will result in minimal costs to the teacher retirement program for the employer share of retirement costs and can be absorbed within existing budgeted resources.'


