COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1213, L.D. 1632, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Community Correction Law"

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

The Department of Corrections will incur some minor additional costs to review county requests to apply funds retained for adult diversion programs for use in juvenile programs. These costs can be absorbed within the department's existing budgeted resources.

The authorization to shift funds may decrease General Fund revenue from interest income. The decreases of revenue will vary based on the actual amount of funds shifted from adult to juvenile programs. The loss of interest income is expected to range from an insignificant loss to a loss of \$20,000 annually.'

This amendment adds a fiscal note to the bill.
