COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1214, L.D. 1633, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Provisions Relating to Mental Examination and Observation of Persons Accused of a Crime"

Amend the bill in section 1 in paragraph A in subparagraph (1) in the 4th line by striking out the following: "his guilt, criminal responsibility or his" and inserting in its place the following: 'his the defendant's guilt, criminal responsibility or his'

Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 2.

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

The Judicial Department may require additional General Fund appropriations to cover the additional costs associated with the expansion of the situations when court-appointed psychiatric examiners will be required. The amount of the additional costs can not be determined at this time.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment removes gender specific language and deletes section 2 of the bill. It also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
