

2 These fees were eliminated by Public Law 1993, chapter 404. The
4 bill restores the inspection and permit requirements for
6 installation of domestic heating appliances, minor plumbing work
8 and minor installations. The restoration of the department's
authority to set fees and the restoration of inspection and
permit requirements will eliminate uncertainty as to when the
fees, inspections and permits are required.
