majority of voters of the district voting by secret ballot at an election called by the School District Committee and advertised conducted according to the laws related to municipal elections, excluding the provisions of Title 30-A, section 2528, subsection 5, paragraph B and Title 30-A, section 5772, subsection 2-A. The municipal officers of the towns are not. required to prepare for posting, nor the town clerks to post, a new list of voters and, for the purpose of registration of voters, the boards of voter registration must be in session on the secular day preceding the special election. The town clerks of the towns shall prepare the required ballots and reduce the subject matter to the wording of an article provided by the District School Committee. Approval of a majority of voters of the district voting by secret ballot to borrow funds to purchase land at the time of the vote to form the Community School District is authority for the School District Committee to borrow funds as provided for in section 1702.'

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## STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment limits the School District Committee from borrowing funds for minor capital costs of more than .025% of the valuation of all 5 towns without approval of a majority of voters at a general election in the district.

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This amendment also corrects an omission in a statutory citation. This amendment also makes a technical correction to the committee amendment.
