HOUSE AMENDMENT "D" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 592, L.D. 1651

Further amend the amendment in Part A in section 3 in that part designated "\$2306." by striking out all of the first indented paragraph (page 10, lines 3 to 17 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

'Every Annually, on or before April 1st, every corporation organized under this chapter shall annually--on--or--before--the first--day--ef--April file in the office of the commissioner 8 superintendent a statement verified by at least 2 of the 10 principal officers of said that corporation showing its condition on the 31st-day-of previous December,-then-next-preceding,-which shall-be-in--such-form-and--shall-contain--such-matters-as--the 12 superintendent-shall-preseribe <u>31st</u>. The statement must be on an annual statement blank of the National Association of Insurance 14 Commissioners for use by nonprofit hospital or medical service corporations, be prepared in accordance with the association's 16 annual statement instructions, follow practices and procedures prescribed by the association's accounting practices and 18 procedures manual and be accompanied by any useful or necessary modification or adaptation and any additional information 20 required by the superintendent.'

Further amend the amendment in Part A in section 10 in paragraph E in the 5th line (page 12, line 37 in amendment) by 24 striking out the following: "sales" and inserting in its place 26 the following: 'a-sales the sole'

Further amend the amendment in Part A in section 23 in that part designated "Sec. 5." in the 2nd and 3rd lines (page 17, lines 30 26 and 27 in amendment) by striking out the following: "insurance commissioner" and inserting in its place the following: 'insurance-commissioner Superintendent of Insurance'

34 Further amend the amendment in Part A in section 27 in the last paragraph in the first and 2nd lines (page 18, lines 35 and 36 36 in amendment) by striking out the following: "Health Maintenance Organization of Maine, referred to in this Act as "HMO Maine,"" and inserting in its place the following: 'HMO Maine,'
