HOUSE AMENDMENT "D" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1243, L.D. 1670, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Harness Racing Laws"

Amend the amendment by inserting after section 2 the following:

'Sec. 3. 8 MRSA §275-D, sub-§1, as enacted by PL 1993, c. 388, §8, is amended to read:

1. Off-track betting on simulcast racing. A person may conduct pari-mutuel wagering at a Class A restaurant or a Class A restaurant/lounge, as defined in Title 28-A, section 2, subsection 15, paragraph R or R-1, or at a facility contiguous to and connected by an internal doorway with a Class A restaurant or a Class A restaurant/lounge in this State if the person is licensed under this section to operate an off-track betting facility at that restaurant ~~is-licensed-as-an-off-track-betting,~~ restaurant/lounge or facility ~~under-this-section.'~~

Further amend the amendment by renumbering the sections to read consecutively.


