

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

2 Sec. 1. 29 MRSA §1368-B, sub-§2, as amended by PL 1989, c.
4 640, is repealed.

6 Sec. 2. 29 MRSA §1368-B, sub-§3, as enacted by PL 1983, c.
8 299, is amended to read:

10 3. Exception and limitation. The requirements of
12 subsections subsection 1 and 2 shall do not apply to any person
14 transporting a child less than 4 years of age and over one year
16 of age when the number of passengers exceeds the seating capacity
18 of the vehicle.

STATEMENT OF FACT

20 This bill removes from the motor vehicle laws the exemption
22 from the use of a child safety seat when the driver is not the
24 parent of the child.

26 This document has not yet been reviewed to determine the
28 need for cross-reference, stylistic and other technical
30 amendments to conform existing law to current drafting standards.
