COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1252, L.D. 1679, Bill, "An Act to Prohibit Electronic Video Machines"

Amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 3 in the first line (page 1, line 9 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "No" and inserting in its place the following: 'Ne A' and by inserting after the following: "may" the following: 'not'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

REVENUES

General Fund (\$93,000)

Prohibiting electronic video machines will reduce General Fund revenue from license fees by approximately \$93,000 annually beginning in fiscal year 1994-95.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment is the minority report and adds a fiscal note to the bill. This amendment also conforms existing law to current drafting standards.
