COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1254, L.D. 1681, Bill, "An Act to Encourage the Establishment or Expansion of Certain Residency Programs Relating to Emergency Medicine Physicians"

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

Any costs associated with administering an emergency physician residency program can be absorbed within existing resources of the Finance Authority of Maine. General Fund appropriations may be required to fund any new residency spaces.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

The amendment adds a fiscal note to the bill.
