

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

4 Sec. 1. 38 MRSA §610-B is enacted to read:

6 §610-B. Legislative oversight of the Northeast Ozone Transport
Commission

8 The member representing this State on the Northeast Ozone
10 Transport Commission, established by the Clean Air Act Amendments
12 of 1990, 42 United States Code, Section 7511c and referred to in
14 this section as the "commission," shall:

16 1. Semi-annual report. Provide semi-annual reports of the
18 commission's activities to the joint standing committee of the
20 Legislature having jurisdiction over air quality issues. Reports
22 must include, but are not limited to, information concerning the
24 following:

26 A. Commission activities pertaining to the adoption of
28 resolutions;

30 B. Recommendations or memoranda of understanding; and

32 C. Any other actions that may recommend that states adopt
34 control strategies; and

36 2. Information prior to final action. Provide to the joint
38 standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over
40 air quality issues proposed recommendations, memoranda of
42 understanding, petitions or other actions that may recommend that
44 states adopt control strategies before final commission action.

46 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

48 This bill requires the representative for Maine serving on
50 the Northeast Ozone Transport Commission to report periodically
to the Joint Standing Committee on Energy and Natural Resources
concerning proposed resolutions, memoranda of understanding and
recommendations and to provide information before certain final
commission actions.

This document has not yet been reviewed to determine the
need for cross-reference, stylistic and other technical
amendments to conform existing law to current drafting standards.
