HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1261, L.D. 1688, Bill, "An Act to Increase Penalties for Violation of Lobster Fishing Laws"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in that part designated "~~S6402-B.~~" in the first paragraph in the 2nd line from the end (page 1, line 35 in amendment) by inserting after "subsection 1" the following: 'if the conviction of the 2nd or subsequent offense involved possession of 3 or more lobsters smaller than that minimum size'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment provides that a lobster and crab fishing license of a licenseholder convicted of a 2nd or subsequent offense may be suspended only if there were 3 or more short lobsters involved in the 2nd or subsequent offense.
