26	Revised Statutes, Title 12, section 6445. Such funds may be borrowed only for the purposes of funding those costs during the
28	start-up phase of the logbook program. Any funds borrowed from the Seed Lobster Fund for these purposes must be reimbursed prior
30	to June 30, 1995 from revenues derived from the sale of logbooks.'
