The amendment requires the Commissioner of Marine Resources to adopt rules requiring the use of logbooks by licensed lobster harvesters. Individual records collected by the department must be treated as confidential and may not be disclosed in a manner or form that permits identification of any person or vessel.

The amendment adds an allocation section and a fiscal note to the bill.
