24	STATEMENT OF FACT
26	
28	This bill enacts a 2-year moratorium on the issuance of any new lobster and crab fishing licenses for calendar years 1995 and 1996. During those 2 years, the Commissioner of Marine Resources
30	may issue a lobster and crab fishing license only to a person who held a valid lobster and crab fishing license on December 31,
32	1993 and who demonstrates to the satisfaction of the commissioner that that person engaged in lobstering activities at some time
34	during the previous 3 years. During that 2-year moratorium period, a lobster and crab fishing license may not authorize the
36	use of more than one deck hand on a lobstering vessel at any time.
38	The bill also requires 3 parlor section vents at least 1 7/8 inches in all lobster traps, extends the Sunday harvesting
40	prohibition to include all weekends between April 1st and November 1st and limits harvesting time during all other days of
42	the year to the period between 6 a.m. and 3 p.m.

48	This document has not yet been reviewed to determine the
50	need for cross-reference, stylistic and other technical amendments to conform existing law to current drafting standards.
