4 **Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA c. 607, as amended, is repealed.**

8 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

10 This bill repeals the law authorizing the Maine School  
12 Building Authority, which was established to assist local school  
14 administrative units in the construction of educational  
16 facilities. Since all of the bonds issued by the authority will  
18 be recalled as of March 1994, the responsibilities of the  
20 authority have been accomplished.

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22 This document has not yet been reviewed to determine the  
need for cross-reference, stylistic and other technical  
amendments to conform existing law to current drafting standards.
