SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 620, L.D. 1722, Bill, "An Act to Promote Economic and Employment Growth in the Financial Services Sector"

Amend the amendment by inserting after section 5 the following:

Sec. 6. Committee review. The joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over banking and insurance matters shall review and evaluate the impact of this Act and shall issue a report detailing that review and evaluation, including recommendations as to whether or not the law should be amended, to the Second Regular Session of the 117th Legislature. The committee is specifically authorized to submit legislation to implement its recommendations to the Second Regular Session of the 117th Legislature.

Further amend the bill by renumbering the sections to read consecutively.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment requires a review and evaluation of the impact of this bill by the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over banking and insurance matters in the Second Regular Session of the 117th Legislature.
