COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1280, L.D. 1728, Bill, "An Act to Establish Retirement Equity for Full-time Adult Education Teachers"

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 1 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §17762, as amended by PL 1989, c. 700, Pt. A, §25, is repealed.'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

The number of full-time adult education teachers whose creditable service will be affected by this bill is so small that there will be no appreciable effect on either the unfunded liability of the Maine State Retirement System or on future employer contribution rates.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment accomplishes the same purpose as the original bill by repealing the statutory provision granting only 1/2 year's service credit for one year of service as a full-time adult education teacher. By repealing this section, adult education teachers will be entitled to the same creditable service as other teachers. The amendment also adds a fiscal note.
