SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1284, L.D. 1732, Bill, "An Act to Establish a System of Performance-based Agreements for the Provision of Certain Social Services"

Amend the bill in section 6 in subsection 2 in the next to the last blocked paragraph in the last line (page 7, line 12 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "Legislative Council." and inserting in its place the following: 'Department of Human Services and the Department of Mental Health and Mental Retardation.'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

'FISCAL NOTE

32 The Department of Human Services and the Department of Mental Health and Mental Retardation will require additional 34 resources beginning in fiscal year 1995-96 to fully implement performance-based contracting. The General Fund appropriations 36 required will depend on the amount of funding available from federal and other sources and on the specific management 38 information needs of the 2 departments at that time which can not be estimated.

The Department of Human Services and the Department of Mental Health and Mental Retardation will incur some minor additional costs during fiscal year 1994-95 to begin the implementation process. These costs can be absorbed within the departments' existing budgeted resources.

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SENATE AMENDMENT

SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1284, L.D. 1732

The additional costs to participate as a member of the oversight committee can be absorbed by the Department of Corrections utilizing existing budgeted resources.

The Department of Human Services and the Department of Mental Health and Mental Retardation can absorb miscellaneous committee costs and the costs related to staffing the committee. The costs associated with printing the committee's report in fiscal year 1998-99 can not be determined. However, General Fund appropriations may be required if those costs are significant.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

The amendment requires that the Department of Human Services and the Department of Mental Health and Mental Retardation, rather than the Legislative Council, are responsible for providing staffing assistance to the committee. The amendment also adds a fiscal note.
