

**An Act to Apportion Districts for the Election of County Commissioners.**

Reported by Representative JOSEPH for the Legislative Apportionment Commission pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 30-A, section 65.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

2           **Sec. 1. 30-A MRSA §66**, as amended by PL 1989, c. 220, §§2 and  
4, is further amended to read:

6           **§66. County commissioner districts**

8           **1. Creation of Androscoggin County Commissioner Districts.**  
Androscoggin County is divided into the following 3 districts.

10           A. Commissioner District Number 1, in the County of  
12 Androscoggin, consists of the municipalities of Greene,  
Leeds, Lisbon, Livermore, Livermore Falls, Sabattus, Turner,  
14 Wales and that portion of the City of Lewiston described as  
follows: ~~Beginning on College Road at the Greene town line;~~  
16 ~~thence in a general southeasterly direction along the Greene~~  
~~town line to Old Greene Road; thence in a general~~  
18 ~~southwesterly direction along Old Greene Road to North~~  
~~Temple Street; thence in a general southwesterly direction~~  
20 ~~along North Temple Street to Sabattus Street; thence in a~~  
~~general westerly direction along Sabattus Street to Nichols~~  
22 ~~Street; thence in a general northeasterly direction along~~  
~~Nichols Street to Holland Street; thence in a general~~  
24 ~~northwesterly direction along Holland Street to College~~  
~~Street; thence in a general northeasterly direction along~~  
26 ~~College Street to the point of beginning designated as Ward~~  
2, Precinct 1. The term of office of the county  
28 commissioner from this district shall expire in 1988 and  
every 4 years thereafter.

30           B. Commissioner District Number 2, in the County of  
32 Androscoggin, consists of the municipalities of Auburn,  
Durham, Mechanic Falls, Minot and Poland. The term of office  
34 of the county commissioner from this district shall expire  
in 1988 and every 4 years thereafter.

36           C. Commissioner District Number 3, in the County of  
38 Androscoggin, consists of all of the City of Lewiston,  
excepting that portion as ~~described in County Commissioner~~  
40 ~~District Number 1~~ designated as Ward 2, Precinct 1. The  
term of office of the county commissioner from this district  
42 shall expire in 1990 and every 4 years thereafter.

44           **2. Creation of Aroostook County Commissioner Districts.**  
Aroostook County is divided into the following 3 districts.

46           A. Commissioner District Number 1 consists of the  
48 municipalities of Amity, Ashland, Bancroft, Benedieta,  
Blaine, Bridgewater, Cary Plantation, Crystal, Dyer Brook, E  
50 ~~Plantation~~, Easton, Fort Fairfield, Garfield Plantation,

2 Glenwood Plantation, Hammond, Haynesville, Hersey, Hodgdon,  
Houlton, Island Falls, Linneus, Littleton, Ludlow, Macwahoc  
4 Plantation, Mars Hill, Masardis, Merrill, Monticello, Moro  
Plantation, Nashville Plantation, New Limerick, Oakfield,  
6 Orient, Oxbow Plantation, Reed Plantation, Sherman, Smyrna,  
Westfield, Weston and the unorganized territories of Central  
8 Aroostook and South Aroostook and that portion of the  
unorganized territory formerly known as E Plantation. The  
term of office of the county commissioner from this district  
10 shall expire in 1990 and every 4 years thereafter.

12 B. Commissioner District Number 2 consists of the  
municipalities of Allagash, Caribou, Castle Hill, Chapman,  
14 Eagle Lake, Mapleton, Perham, Portage Lake, Presque Isle,  
St. Francis, St. John Plantation, Wade, Washburn,  
16 Westmanland, Winterville Plantation and the unorganized  
territories of Northwest Aroostook and Square Lake. The term  
18 of office of the commissioner from this district shall  
expire in 1988 and every 4 years thereafter.

20 C. Commissioner District Number 3 consists of the  
municipalities of Caswell Plantation, Cyr Plantation, Fort  
22 Kent, Frenchville, Grand Isle, Hamlin, Limestone, Madawaska,  
24 New Canada, New Sweden, Saint Agatha, Stockholm, Van Buren,  
Wallagrass Plantation, and Woodland and the unorganized  
26 territory of Connor. The term of office of the commissioner  
from this district shall expire in 1988 and every 4 years  
28 thereafter.

30 **3. Creation of Cumberland County Commissioner Districts.**  
Cumberland County is divided into the following 3 districts.

32 A. Commissioner District Number 1 consists of the  
municipalities of Cumberland, Falmouth, Long Island, North  
34 Yarmouth and Portland. The term of office of the  
36 commissioner from this district shall expire in 1988 and  
every 4 years thereafter.

38 B. Commissioner District Number 2 consists of the  
municipalities of Baldwin, Cape Elizabeth, Gorham,  
40 Scarborough, South Portland, Standish and Westbrook. The  
term of office of the commissioner from this district shall  
42 expire in 1988 and every 4 years thereafter.

44 C. Commissioner District Number 3 consists of the  
municipalities of Bridgton, Brunswick, Casco, ~~Cumberland,~~  
46 Freeport, Gray, Harpswell, Harrison, Naples, New Gloucester,  
48 ~~North--Yarmouth,~~ Pownal, Raymond, Sebago, Windham and  
Yarmouth. The term of office of the commissioner from this  
50 district shall expire in 1990 and every 4 years thereafter.

2           **4. Creation of Franklin County Commissioner Districts.**  
Franklin County is divided into the following 3 districts.

6           A. Commissioner District Number 1 consists of the  
8           municipalities of Carthage, Jay and Wilton. The term of  
office of the commissioner from this district shall expire  
in 1988 and every 4 years thereafter.

10          B. Commissioner District Number 2 consists of the  
12          municipalities of Chesterville, Farmington, ~~Industry~~ and New  
Sharon. The term of office of the commissioner from this  
district shall expire in 1988 and every 4 years thereafter.

14  
16          C. Commissioner District Number 3 consists of the  
18          municipalities of Avon, Carrabassett Valley, Carthage,  
Coplin Plantation, Dallas Plantation, Eustis, Industry,  
20          Kingfield, Madrid, New Vineyard, Phillips, Rangeley  
Plantation, Rangeley, Sandy River Plantation, Strong,  
22          Temple, Weld and the unorganized territories of East Central  
Franklin, North Franklin, South Franklin, West Central  
24          Franklin and Wyman. The term of office of the commissioner  
from this district shall expire in 1990 and every 4 years  
thereafter.

26           **5. Creation of Hancock County Commissioner Districts.**  
Hancock County is divided into the following 3 districts.

28  
30          A. Commissioner District Number 1 consists of the  
32          municipalities of Amherst, Aurora, Blue Hill, Dedham,  
Eastbrook, Ellsworth, Gouldsboro, Great Pond, Mariaville,  
34          Osborn, Otis, Sorrento, Sullivan, Surry, Waltham, Winter  
Harbor and the unorganized territories of Central Hancock,  
East Hancock and ~~North~~ Northwest Hancock. The term of  
office of the commissioner from this district shall expire  
36          in 1988 and every 4 years thereafter.

38          B. Commissioner District Number 2 consists of the  
40          municipalities of Brooklin, Brooksville, Bucksport, Castine,  
Dedham, Deer Isle, Orland, Penobscot, Sedgwick, Stonington  
42          and Verona. The term of office of the commissioner from  
this district shall expire in 1990 and every 4 years  
thereafter.

46          C. Commissioner District Number 3 consists of the  
48          municipalities of Bar Harbor, Cranberry Isles, Franklin,  
Frenchboro, Hancock, Lamoine, Mount Desert, Southwest  
Harbor, Swan's Island, Tremont and Trenton. The term of  
office of the commissioner from this district shall expire  
50          in 1988 and every 4 years thereafter.

2           **6. Creation of Kennebec County Commissioner Districts.**  
3 Kennebec County is divided into the following 3 districts.

5           A. Commissioner District Number 1 consists of the  
6 municipalities of Augusta, Chelsea, China, Randolph, Sidney,  
7 Vassalboro and Windsor. The term of office of the  
8 commissioner from this district shall expire in 1988 and  
9 every 4 years thereafter.

10  
11           B. Commissioner District Number 2 consists of the  
12 municipalities of Belgrade, Farmingdale, Fayette, Gardiner,  
13 Hallowell, Litchfield, Manchester, Monmouth, Mount Vernon,  
14 Pittston, Readfield, Rome, Vienna, Wayne, West Gardiner and  
15 Winthrop. The term of office of the commissioner from this  
16 district shall expire in 1990 and every 4 years thereafter.

17  
18           C. Commissioner District Number 3 consists of the  
19 municipalities of Albion, Benton, Clinton, Oakland,  
20 Waterville, Winslow and Unity Township. The term of office  
21 of the commissioner from this district shall expire in 1988  
22 and every 4 years thereafter.

23           **7. Creation of Knox County Commissioner Districts.** Knox  
24 County is divided into the following 3 districts.

26           A. Commissioner District Number 1 consists of the  
27 municipalities of Owls Head, Rockland and ~~South-Thomaston~~  
28 Rockport. The term of office of the commissioner from this  
29 district shall expire in 1990 and every 4 years thereafter.

31           B. Commissioner District Number 2 consists of the  
32 municipalities of Cushing, Friendship, ~~Isle--au--Haut,~~  
33 ~~Matinicus--Isle--Plantation,--North--Haven,~~ St. George, South

35 territory of Criehaven. The term of office of the  
36 commissioner from this district shall expire in 1988 and  
37 every 4 years thereafter.

the commissioner from this district shall expire in 1988 and  
every 4 years thereafter.

6 B. Commissioner District Number 2 consists of the

Nobleboro, South Bristol and Waldoboro. The term of office  
10 of the commissioner from this district shall expire in 1990  
and every 4 years thereafter.

Jefferson, Newcastle, Somerville, Whitefield and the  
16 unorganized territory of Hibberts Gore. The term of office

20 **9. Creation of Oxford County Commissioner Districts.**  
Oxford County is divided into the following 3 districts.

Fryeburg, Gilead, Hanover, Hiram, Lovell, Newry, Norway,  
26 Porter, Stoneham, Stow, Sweden, Waterford and the  
unorganized territories of ~~North Oxford and those portions~~  
28 ~~of South Oxford known as~~ Batchelders Grant and Mason. The  
term of office of the commissioner from this district shall  
30 expire in 1988 and every 4 years thereafter.

32 B. Commissioner District Number 2 consists of the

34 Lincoln Plantation, Magalloway Plantation, Mexico, Newry,

38 every 4 years thereafter.

40 C. Commissioner District Number 3 consists of the

42 Hebron, Otisfield, Oxford, Paris, Sumner, West Paris,  
Woodstock and the unorganized territories of Milton and ~~that~~  
44 ~~portion of South Oxford known as~~ Albany. The term of office  
of the commissioner from this district shall expire in 1990  
46 and every 4 years thereafter.

48 **10. Creation of Penobscot County Commissioner Districts.**  
Penobscot County is divided into the following 3 districts.

4 office of the commissioner from this district shall expire  
in 1988 and every 4 years thereafter.

of the commissioner from this district shall expire in 1988  
12 and every 4 years thereafter.

14 C. Commissioner District Number 3 consists of the  
municipalities of Alton, Bradford, Bradley, Burlington,  
16 Carroll Plantation, Charleston, Chester, Clifton, Drew  
Plantation, East Millinocket, Edinburg, Enfield, Garland,  
18 Greenbush, Greenfield, Howland, Hudson, Lagrange, Lakeville,  
Lee, Lincoln, Lowell, Mattawamkeag, Maxfield, Medway,  
20 Milford, Millinocket, Mount Chase, Old Town, Passadumkeag,

effective date of this Act continues to serve the remainder of  
24 the term for which elected. In York County, any person holding  
the office of county commissioner on the effective date of this  
26 Act continues to serve in that capacity until the 5 county  
commissioners provided in this Act are elected.
