2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 37-B MRSAs §801, sub-§4, ¶C is enacted to read:**

6 C. Public schools are exempt from registration fees and
8 inventory fees imposed pursuant to this section on
10 underground storage tanks. This paragraph does not exempt a
12 public school from registration or inventory requirements
14 other than the payment of fees for underground storage tanks.

16 **Sec. 2. Refund of fees paid.** Registration and inventory fees
18 imposed pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 37-B,
20 section 801 paid by public schools for underground storage tanks
22 must be refunded to those schools no later than October 1, 1994.

26 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

28 This bill exempts public schools from the inventory and
30 registration fees imposed for underground storage tanks.
