	Whereas, Acadia Hospital Corporation, a not-for-profit,
6	100-bed psychiatric hospital located in Bangor, opened on August
_	27, 1992 and began serving Medicaid patients pursuant to the
8	terms of a provider enrollment agreement executed with the Department of Human Services; and

20	STATEMENT OF FACT
22	SIAIDMENT OF PACE
	This bill clarifies the reimbursement treatment to be
24	afforded to new psychiatric hospitals. Under this bill, a psychiatric hospital that begins operation on or after August 1,
26	1993 is guaranteed that the terms of an executed provider enrollment agreement will be honored and that Medicaid
28	reimbursement will be made. The bill also ensures that the terms of any state Medicaid plan and Maine Health Care Finance
30	Commission rules concerning disproportionate share payments apply to new psychiatric hospitals.
