COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1294, L.D. 1742, Bill, "An Act Concerning High-speed Chases"

Amend the bill in the emergency preamble by striking out all of the 3rd paragraph (page 1, lines 9 and 10 in L.D.)

Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 1.

Further amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 5 in the first paragraph in the 4th and 5th lines (page 1, lines 43 and 44 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "and is liable for all damages resulting from the high-speed chase"

Further amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 5 in paragraph A in the first line (page 1, line 48 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "it" the following: 'is' and in the 2nd and 3rd lines (page 1, lines 49 and 50 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "or the liability established by this subsection"

Further amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 5 in paragraph B in the 2nd and 3rd lines (page 2, lines 3 and 4 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "and to the liability established by this subsection"

Further amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 5 in paragraph B in subparagraph (1) in the 2nd and 3rd lines (page 2, lines 7 and 8 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "in violation"
