COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 627, L.D. 1746, "Resolve, Authorizing the State Tax Assessor to Convey the Interest of the State in Certain Real Estate in the Unorganized Territory"

Amend the resolve by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

Any funds received through sales of these parcels in an amount above the amount of taxes due will be placed in the Unorganized Territory Education and Services Fund. The amount of additional dedicated revenue will depend on the prices received for the parcels.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment adds a fiscal note to the resolve.
