COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 1296, L.D. 1751, Bill, "An Act to Maintain State-staffed Crisis Programs"

Amend the bill in section 1 by striking out all of the 7th to 15th lines (page 1, lines 29 to 39 in L.D.) and inserting in their place the following:

'Positions - Legislative Count	(12.0)
Personal Services	\$547,016
All Other	(547,016)

Provides for a line category transfer, including funds for 2 Mental Health and Mental Retardation Casework Supervisor positions and 10 Psychiatric Social Worker II positions to maintain state-staffed crisis programs.'

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

This amendment provides funding for 12 positions through a General Fund line category transfer from the All Other line category to the Personal Services line category within the Department of Mental Health and Mental Retardation to maintain state-staffed crisis programs in Cumberland County and York County. The 6 positions in Kennebec County will remain privatized as enacted by the First Regular Session of the 116th Legislature.'

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT

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STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment represents the minority report of the Joint Standing Committee on Appropriations and Financial Affairs. It provides funding for 12 positions through a General Fund line category transfer from the All Other line category to the Personal Services line category within the Department of Mental Health and Mental Retardation to maintain certain state-staffed mental health crisis programs in fiscal year 1994-95 while allowing certain mental health crisis programs to privatize as enacted by the First Regular Session of the 116th Legislature.
