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

HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1303, L.D. 1758, Bill, "An Act to Protect the Rights of Employees and to Ensure the Proper Expenditure of Public Funds"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in that part designated "§872." in subsection 3 by inserting at the end the following: 'The personnel records of an employee that are considered confidential for state employees under Title 5, section 7070 are not subject to disclosure.'
