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

SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1303, L.D. 1758, Bill, "An Act to Protect the Rights of Employees and to Ensure the Proper Expenditure of Public Funds"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in that part designated "~~S872.~~" in subsection 3 in the last line (page 2, line 18 in amendment) by inserting after "subsection 3" the following: 'including personnel records as defined in Title 5, section 7070.'

This amendment adds the personnel records of employees in classified service and unclassified service of the Executive Department and the Legislative Department to the list of records that are not considered public records.
