Part N, section 1 repeals the Property Tax Relief Fund as established in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 30-A, section 5683, enacted by Public Law 1989, chapter 534, Part F. The Property Tax Relief Fund assists local property tax payers by reducing the cost of local government infrastructure investments paid for with local property taxes. Last year, for the first time since 1989, \$3,100,000 was distributed to municipalities from the fund and used to pay for local infrastructure, repairs, maintenance and construction.
