HOUSE AMENDMENT "E" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1306, L.D. 1761, Bill, "An Act to Make Supplemental Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government and to Change Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper Operations of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1994 and June 30, 1995"

Amend the amendment in Part F in section 4 in the next to the last line (page 126, line 28 in amendment) by striking out the following: "4,000,000" and inserting in its place the following: '4,950,000'

Further amend the amendment in Part F in section 4 in the last line (page 126, line 30 in amendment) by striking out the following: "\$519,072,022" and inserting in its place the following: '\$520,022,022'

Further amend the amendment in Part F in section 6 in the last line (page 126, line 46 in amendment) by striking out the following: "\$519,072,022" and inserting in its place the following: '\$520,022,022'

Further amend the amendment by adding at the end before the emergency clause the following:
