SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1306, L.D. 1761, Bill, "An Act to Make Supplemental Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government and to Change Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper Operations of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1994 and June 30, 1995"

Amend the amendment by inserting after Part CC the following:

PART DD

Sec. DD-1. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Part.

Provides funds in fiscal year 1993-94 to offset a deappropriation in Part A, section 1 and deappropriates funds in fiscal year 1994-95 by decreasing payments to School Administrative District #61 to reflect the district's share of accumulated interest payable on employer retirement costs.'

FISCAL NOTE

This amendment will have no net effect on General Fund
appropriations and revenue and a balanced budget is maintained
for fiscal year 1993-94 and fiscal year 1994-95.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment transfers a deappropriation to School
Administrative District #61 from fiscal year 1993-94 to fiscal
year 1994-95 so that the reduced monthly General Purpose Aid for
Local Schools payments to that district can be distributed over a
longer period of time.
