In pursuance of Article III of said the compact there shall 18 bе are 3 members, hereinafter in this subchapter called 20 "commissioners"," of the Atlantic States Marine Fisheries Commission, hereinafter in this subchapter called "commission"," from the State of Maine. The first commissioner from the State of 22 Maine shall must be the Commissioner of Marine Resources of the State of Maine ex officio, and the term of any such ex officio 24 commissioner shall <u>must</u> terminate at the time he that commissioner ceases to hold said the office of Commissioner of .26 Marine Resources and his <u>that commissioner's</u> successor as 28 commissioner shall must be his that commissioner's successor as Commissioner of Marine Resources. The 2nd commissioner from the 30 State of Maine shall must be a Legislator and-member-ef-the-Maine Commission-on-Interstate-Cooperation-ex--officio,-designated-by said-Maine-Commission-on-Interstate-Cooperation,-and-the-term-of 32 any-such-ex-officio-commissioner-shall-terminate-at-the-time-he eeases--to--hold--said--legislative--office--or--said--office--as 34 commissioner--on--interstate--cooperation/--and-his--successor--as 36 commissioner-shall-be-named-in-like-manner appointed jointly by the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives. The terms of each of the initial 3 members shall begin at the date of the appointment of the appointive commissioner, provided the said compact shall must then have gone into effect in accordance with Article II of the compact; otherwise they-shall the terms begin upon the date upon which said the compact shall--become becomes effective in accordance with said Article II.

Further amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering 14 any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

FISCAL NOTE

This amendment will have no net effect on General Fund appropriations and revenue and a balanced budget is maintained for fiscal year 1993-94 and fiscal year 1994-95.

The costs associated with increasing the salary ranges of 24 the Assistant Secretary of the Senate and the Assistant Clerk of the House of Representatives can be absorbed within the 26 legislature's budgeted resources.

STATEMENT OF FACT

 This amendment transfers a deappropriation to School Administrative District #61 from fiscal year 1993-94 to fiscal
year 1994-95 so that the reduced monthly General Purpose Aid for Local Schools payments to that district can be distributed over a
longer period of time.

36 This amendment also increases the salary range of the Assistant Secretary of the Senate and the Assistant Clerk of the 38 House of Representatives.
