
FISCAL NOTE

This amendment provides a supplemental appropriation of
\$1,520,000 in fiscal year 1994-95 to the General Purpose Aid for
Local Schools program. This funding is achieved by eliminating
supplemental appropriations for the Magnet School at Limestone
and the York County Technical College.
