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Sec. EE-1. 12 MRSA §4652, first \P , as amended by PL 1975, c. 771, $\S154$, is further amended to read:

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In pursuance of Article III of said the compact there shall 3 members, hereinafter in this subchapter called "commissioners"," of the Atlantic States Marine Fisheries Commission, hereinafter in this subchapter called "commission"," from the State of Maine. The first commissioner from the State of Maine shall must be the Commissioner of Marine Resources of the State of Maine ex officio, and the term of any such ex officio <u>must</u> terminate at the time commissioner shall commissioner ceases to hold said the office of Commissioner of Marine Resources and his that commissioner's successor as commissioner shall must be his that commissioner's successor as Commissioner of Marine Resources. The 2nd commissioner from the State of Maine shall must be a Legislator and-member-ef-the-Maine Commission -- on - Interstate -- Gooperation - ex -- officier -- designated -- by said-Maine-Commission-on-Interstate-Cooperation,-and-the-term-of any-such-ex-officio-commissioner-shall-terminate-at-the-time-he seases -- te--held -- said -- legislative -- office -- or -- said -- office -- as commissioner--on--interstate--cooperation/--and--his--successor--as semmissioner-shall-be-named-in-like-manner appointed jointly by the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives. The Legislator appointed as the 2nd commissioner serves until the end of the term of the Legislature in which that person was appointed or until replaced by the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives. The Governor shall appoint a citizen as a 3rd commissioner who shall must have a knowledge of and interest in the marine fisheries problem. The term of said that commissioner shall-be is 3 years and he-shall-held that commissioner holds office until his a successor shall-be is appointed and qualified. Vacancies occurring in the office of such that commissioner from for any reason or cause shall must be filled by appointment by the Governor for the unexpired term. The Commissioner of Marine Resources as ex officio commissioner may delegate, from time to any deputy or other subordinate in his commissioner's department or office the power to be present and participate, including voting as his that commissioner's representative or substitute at any meeting of or hearing by or other proceeding of the commission. The terms of each of the initial 3 members shall begin at the date of the appointment of the appointive commissioner, provided the said compact shall must then have gone into effect in accordance with Article II of the

L.D. 1761 compact; otherwise they-shall the terms begin upon the date upon 2 which said the compact shall--become becomes effective in accordance with said Article II.'
