SENATE AMENDMENT "I" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1306, L.D. 1761, Bill, "An Act to Make Supplemental Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government and to Change Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper Operations of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1994 and June 30, 1995"

Amend the amendment by inserting after Part CC and before the emergency clause the following:

PART DD

Sec. DD-1. 3 MRSA §162-A, sub-§2, as repealed and replaced by PL 1987, c. 349, Pt. K, §1, is repealed.

Further amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

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
This amendment removes the statutory salary range assignment
