The 115th Legislature, through enactment of Resolve 1991, chapter 43, directed the Maine Technical College System Board of Trustees to establish the Commission to Study the Need for a Technical College in York County. The commission, composed of leaders from the business community, membership organizations, education and labor throughout the southern part of the State, upon conducting a series of meetings, including public hearings, to collect and analyze data and public opinion, concluded that a technical college should be established for the availability of technical education to the citizens of York County. amendment appropriates the necessary funds to the Maine Technical College System to establish a technical college in York. will allow for the hiring of the administrators, faculty and other staff, training equipment for programs, rental of facilities and other needs of a new college. Programs will be ready for incoming students in January 1995.
