**STATEMENT OF FACT**

26 The 115th Legislature, through its enactment of Resolve  
26 1991, chapter 43, directed the Maine Technical College System  
28 Board of Trustees to establish the Commission to Study the Need  
28 for a Technical College in York County. The commission, composed  
30 of leaders from the business community, membership organizations,  
30 education and labor throughout the southern part of the State,  
32 upon conducting a series of meetings, including public hearings,  
32 to collect and analyze data and public opinion, concluded that a  
34 technical college should be established for the availability of  
34 technical education to the citizens of York County. This bill  
36 appropriates the necessary funds to the Maine Technical College  
36 System to establish a technical college in York County.
