

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

2 Sec. 1. 29 MRSA §1255, as amended by PL 1989, c. 108, §3, is
4 further amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read:

6 The fine for a person convicted of a violation of this
8 section is double the amount assessed for a similar motor vehicle
moving violation not committed in a construction or maintenance
10 area.

12 STATEMENT OF FACT

14 This bill doubles the amount of any civil fine imposed upon
16 a person found guilty of a moving motor vehicle violation that
18 occurred in a designated construction or maintenance area on a
highway.
