4 Notwithstanding paragraphs A to D and for fiscal year 1992-93 only, the state valuation and resident pupil information used to calculate the shared cost for each municipality must be the same as the information used for fiscal year 1991-92.

Notwithstanding paragraphs A to D, Title 30-A, chapter 208-A or any other provision of law, the state valuation used to calculate 10 the shared cost for each municipality in a community school district with a municipal incentive development zone must include 12 the increase in equalized just value of all industrial and commercial property located in the zone over the assessed value.' 14

Further amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 1 in the 16 13th line from the end (page 5, line 4 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "Such" and inserting in its place the following: 18 'Such The'

Further amend the bill by renumbering the sections to read 22 consecutively.

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the 24 statement of fact the following:

'FISCAL NOTE

30 The additional costs to develop rules related to the development of municipal incentive development zones and to approve and certify the establishment of any such zones can be 32 absorbed by the Department of Economic and Community Development utilizing existing budgeted resources.' 34

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment requires that the state valuation used to calculate the local share of education for municipalities in a 40 school district or community school district include the value of 42 all property in the municipal incentive development zone.

amendment also conforms existing law to current 44 This drafting standards and adds a fiscal note to the bill.

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
