Whereas,** Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the 90-day period may not terminate until after the beginning of the next fiscal year; and

8 Whereas, certain obligations and expenses incident to the operation of the Maine Emergency Management Agency are now due 10 and payable; and

12 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of 14 Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and 16 safety; now, therefore,

Sec. 1. 37-B MRSA §744, sub-§2-A, ¶C is enacted to read:

C. State funding for disaster assistance to state and local government units for presidentially declared disasters for the purpose of repairing or replacing publicly owned facilities is established as follows.

(1) One tenth of a cent per gallon of the "gasoline28tax" referred to in Title 36, chapter 451 must be
credited to the Disaster Relief Fund of the agency as30dedicated revenue.

 32 (2) The agency is authorized to use the money credited to the Disaster Relief Fund as the state match for public disaster relief grants as limited by the provisions of paragraphs A and B.

(3) If any money is not expended during the year in
which the money is collected, the unexpended balance
does not lapse, but must be carried forward to be used
for the purposes specified in this paragraph.

Sec. 2. 37-B MRSA §745 is enacted to read:

44 §745. Disaster Relief Fund

46 The Disaster Relief Fund is established to be used by the agency as a nonlapsing fund for carrying out the purposes of

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill will transfer 1/10 of a cent from the gasoline tax collected to a Disaster Relief Fund administered and expended by the Maine Emergency Management Agency.

Disaster Relief Fund money will be used to pay the state obligated share of public assistance for presidentially declared disasters. Roads, bridges, dams and culverts are the most typical uses. Since 1987, the state share has been \$1,600,000 annually. The fund should support the annual cost.

This document has not yet been reviewed to determine the need for cross-reference, stylistic and other technical amendments to conform existing law to current drafting standards.
