'FISCAL NOTE

The Bureau of Human Resources, within the Department of Administrative and Financial Services can absorb the costs related to determining and approving recruitment and retention adjustments for occupations within state mental health institutions and at the Governor Baxter School for the Deaf. If it is determined that such adjustments are necessary, General Fund appropriations and Other Special Revenue allocations will be required by the Department of Mental Health and Mental Retardation and General Fund appropriations will be required by the Department of Education. The amount of any appropriations or allocations can not be determined at this time.'
