HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 669, L.D. 1837, Bill, "An Act to Subject Motorists with Prior Out-of-state Operating-under-the-influence Convictions to the Sentencing Provisions of the State's Operating-under-the-influence Laws"

Amend the amendment in subparagraph (4) in the 2nd line (page 2, line 3 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "Nation" the following: 'or the Passamaquoddy Tribe'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment provides that prior operating-under-the-influence convictions rendered by the Passamaquoddy Tribal Court may also be considered in sentencing for subsequent state operating-under-the-influence convictions.
