
**An Act to Ensure Adequate Administrative Support for Professional  
Regulatory Boards.**

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, a Clerk Typist III position is needed in the Division of Licensing and Enforcement within the Department of Professional and Financial Regulation as of July 1, 1994; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

**Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

**Sec. 1. Allocation.** The following funds are allocated from Other Special Revenue to carry out the purposes of this Act.

Provides for the allocation of funds for one Clerk Typist III position to adequately support professional regulatory boards internal to the Department of Professional and Financial Regulation.

**Sec. 2. Contingency.** This Act takes effect July 1, 1994 if the State Board of Optometry and the Board of Examiners of Podiatrists are internalized within the Department of Professional and Financial Regulation.

**Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act takes effect July 1, 1994, unless otherwise indicated.
