SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1362, L.D. 1841, Bill, "An Act to Create Retirement Alternatives"

Amend the bill in section 5 by inserting at the end the following:

'3. The committee shall review whether teacher or state employee membership in a pension or retirement system of the State should be an enforceable contractual relationship and, if so, of what that contractual relationship should consist. Based on its review, the committee may propose legislation establishing in law such a contractual relationship.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment requires that the Committee to Create Retirement Alternatives review whether teacher or state employee membership in a pension or retirement system of the State should be an enforceable contractual relationship and, if so, of what that relationship should consist. This amendment permits the committee, based on its review, to propose legislation establishing in law such a relationship.
