COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 673, L.D. 1845, "Resolve, Concerning Reauthorization of the \$9,520,000 Bond Issue for Construction and Renovation of Juvenile Correctional Facilities"

Amend the resolve by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'Resolve, Concerning Reauthorization of the \$6,500,000 Unissued Balance of the \$9,520,000 Bond Issue for Construction and Renovation of Juvenile Correctional Facilities.'

Further amend the resolve in section 1 in the 2nd line (page 1, line 4 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "for the" the following: '\$6,500,000 unissued balance of the'

Further amend the resolve in section 3 in the 2nd line (page 1, line 16 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "reauthorize" the following: '\$6,500,000 in'

Further amend the resolve by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

This resolve reauthorizes \$9,520,000 of a bond issue for construction and renovation of juvenile correctional facilities approved by the voters in November 1989 that currently has an unissued balance of \$6,500,000. This question does not need to go back to the voters. Therefore, no additional referendum expenditures will be required. In addition, no additional appropriations will be required by the Debt Service Account within the Office of the Treasurer.

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT

2 Future General Fund appropriations will be required by the
3 Department of Corrections for the staffing and operational needs
4 of the new correctional facilities. The first operational years
5 of the facilities and the amount of the appropriations can not be
6 determined at this time.'

10 **STATEMENT OF FACT**

11 This amendment clarifies that the reauthorization for
12 issuance applies to the \$6,500,000 balance in authorized but
13 unissued bonds from the original allocation of \$9,520,000 in
14 1989. This amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
