Sec. 2. Findings; reauthorization necessary. Resolved: That the Legislature finds that, unless the bond issue is reauthorized, the progress made in constructing and renovating juvenile correctional facilities will be seriously hindered; and be it further

**Sec. 3. Reauthorization of bonds. Resolved:** That it is the intent of the Legislature to reauthorize bonds not yet issued from the \$9,520,000 bond issue for construction and renovation of juvenile correctional facilities for an additional 5-year period from the effective date of this resolve; and be it further

Sec. 4. Appropriation. Resolved: That no additional appropriation is required to carry out the purposes of this resolve.

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

This resolve provides the necessary extension for the \$9,520,000 bond issue approved by voters in November 1989 in accordance with Private and Special Law 1989, c. 90 for constructional and renovation of juvenile correctional facilities. The Constitution of Maine, Article IX, Section 14 allows the Legislature to extend for an additional 5-year period any unissued bonds.

This document has not yet been reviewed to determine the need for cross-reference, stylistic and other technical amendments to conform existing law to current drafting standards.
