

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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3 **Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §4603, sub-§4**, as enacted by PL 1985, c. 753,
4 §§14 and 15, is amended to read:

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7 **4. Terms of executive council membership.** Once elected,
8 executive council members shall serve for 2 years, provided that
9 the members may continue to serve until a successor is duly
10 elected and qualified and that executive council members may not
11 serve more than 3 5 consecutive terms.

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13 STATEMENT OF FACT

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15 This bill changes the terms for executive council membership
16 on the Maine Potato Board from 3 consecutive terms to 5
17 consecutive terms.
