SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1372, L.D. 1856, Bill, "An Act Concerning the 1993 Apportionment of Legislative Districts"

Amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 11 by striking out all of paragraph A (page 5, lines 7 to 17 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'A. In Knox County, the municipality of Appleton; and'

Further amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 12 by striking out all of paragraph A (page 5, lines 28 to 41 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'A. In Knox County, the municipalities and unorganized territories of Camden, Criedhaven unorganized territory, Cushing, Friendship, Hope, Isle Au Haut, Matinicus Isle Plantation, North Haven, Owls Head, Rockland, Rockport, St. George, South Thomaston, Thomaston, Union, Vinalhaven, Warren and Washington.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment apportions the entire Town of Hope to Senate District 12. The bill split the town into 2 Senate districts.
