30	1. Legislative designee. The employee is designated by the head of a department or agency to serve as the legislative

•	2. Lobbying requirements. The job description of the
34	employee contains lobbying requirements; and
36	3. Lobbying activities. More than 50% of the employee's time is engaged in lobbying activities.

40	An employee registering under this section is exempt from all other requirements under the law regarding lobbyists.'
