COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 690, L.D. 1876, Bill, "An Act Concerning Municipally Owned and Operated Solid Waste Incinerators"

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the statement of fact and inserting in its place the following:

Sec. 1. 38 MRSA §352, sub-§5-A, in that part designated "TABLE II" related to "Title 38, SECTION 1310-N," paragraph B is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

B. Incineration facilities

<u>1. New or expanded for the acceptance of municipal or special wastes, or both</u>	<u>3,500</u>	<u>5,000</u>
<u>2. Municipally owned and operated solid waste incinerators with licensed capacity of 10 tons per day or less</u>	<u>3,500</u>	<u>1,000</u>

Sec. 2. 38 MRSA §352, sub-§5-B, in that part designated "TABLE II" related to "Title 38, SECTION 1304," paragraph I is enacted to read:

<u>I. Municipally owned and operated solid waste incinerators with licensed capacity of 10 tons per day or less</u>	<u>3,500</u>	<u>1,000</u>

2 **Sec. 3. Retroactivity.** This Act takes effect retroactively to
4 July 1, 1993.

STATEMENT OF FACT

20 This amendment replaces the bill.

22 The amendment creates a new license fee category for solid
24 waste incinerators that are owned and operated by a municipality
26 and that have a licensed capacity of 10 tons per day or less.

28 The amendment applies this new category retroactively, to
 July 1, 1993, the date of the most recent fee schedule changes
30 adopted by the Board of Environmental Protection.

 The amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
